

CODE OF CONDUCT – PARENTS & PITCREW

- Parents should encourage children to always participate according to the rules and to follow all officials' decisions.
- Encourage your child to have fun. Remember that children race for enjoyment. They are not racing for the entertainment of parents or spectators. They are not miniature professionals. (Even professionals should enjoy what they are doing.)
- Remember that children learn best from example. Be positive, no matter the outcome.
- Never ridicule or yell at a driver for making a mistake or losing a race.
- Encourage good sporting behaviour.
- Support all efforts to eradicate verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- Recognise the value and importance of all volunteers.
- Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by not using foul language, harassing other drivers, parents, pit crew, officials or volunteers.
- If you disagree with an official, raise the issue through the Clerk of Course.
