4.6.	<p>If time permits Albany City Kart Club may allow a Come and Try session at the end of racing: People wishing to "Have a Go" in a friends or relatives kart, must sign an insurance indemnity form and comply with ALL KA regulations regarding this.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cadet age children can only use karts with MiniRok or Comer engines. • Junior age children can only use karts with Restricted KA100 or Yamaha J engines. • Seniors can only use karts with Yamaha J or Restricted KA100 engines , Yamaha S engines or RESTRICTED 125 engines. • All Have A Go drivers must be wearing a minimum of long pants (jeans), long sleeves, gloves and enclosed shoes. Race suits are recommended, but not compulsory. • Come and Try session will be supervised by the clubs KA Officials.

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
