If insufficient entries are received for a Class and/or Division to form in its own right, the Compulsory Competition Classes will be Consolidated in accordance with Competition Rules - Chapter 1, Rule 9. Discretionary Competition Classes may be Consolidated in accordance with the Rules or cancelled at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.				
7.3.	If a Class or Division is cancelled, the Entry Fee may be refunded at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.				

3. SPECIFIC COVID-19 RESTRICTION AND MITIGATION REQUIREMENTS

THE CLUB HAS COMPLETED A COVIDSafe ACTION PLAN

The Plan has been submitted to Karting WA and where required by law, to the relevant State Government Department. All actions identified as being required to be done to create a COVIDSafe Event and Club facility must be carried prior to and during the Event.

1.	PERMITTED AND NON-PERMITTED PERSONS
1.1.	No person who has symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (this includes any fever, respiratory

	symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, lack of smell or fatigue) is permitted to attend the Circuit or participate in the Event.
1.2.	Any person who starts to feel unwell or to exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 during the Event must immediately avoid contact with all persons at the Circuit and MUST IMMEDIATELY LEAVE the Circuit.
1.3.	<p>Note – The Organising Club must ensure that the maximum number of people (the combined total of Essential Personnel and Permitted Persons) permitted to gather in total at an Event and in groups in accordance with State Public Health Authority Orders/Directions/Regulations is not exceeded at any time prior to or during the Event.</p> <p>Essential Karting Personnel is defined as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Club President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary; and • COVIDSafe Officer • Essential Officials identified in Section 1.7 and 1.8 of these Regulations • First Aid Attendant; and • Administration and Access Control Attendant/s • Event Operations staff (includes but is not limited to canteen staff, cleaners etc).
1.4.	<p>Permitted Persons</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A Licensed Driver (Driver) who has booked their entry in the Event plus a maximum of Unlimited other people per kart who must be either: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The Parent, Legal Guardian, or family member of the Driver; or ○ The Participant License Holder for the Driver; or ○ A Mechanic whose sole task it is, is to prepare, adjust, repair the kart as may be required; • A Person who is approved by the Club to supply karting components and provide specialised karting service to any Permitted Persons in attendance at the Activity.
1.5.	Non-Permitted Persons SPECTATORS are permitted to be in attendance.
2.	SOCIAL DISTANCING AND DENSITY REQUIRMENTS
2.1.	Government prescribed Social Distancing measures must be observed at all times.
2.2.	The use by Permitted Persons of any indoor facilities is strictly limited by the Density Quotient of the room as included in the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan.
3.	KARTING AUSTRALIA COVID-19 DECLARATION
3.1	<p>Under NO circumstances is ANYONE who has been overseas in the previous 14 days or been in contact with a person who is known to be COVID-19 positive, permitted to attend the Circuit.</p> <p>All Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons MUST:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete and submit the <u>Karting Australia COVID-19 Declaration</u> at least 24 hours before the commencement time of the Event; and <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If you have been overseas in the 14 days before the Activity or if you have been in contact with a Covid-19 Positive person, you will not be granted access to the Circuit.

3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via IN and OUT grids at the discretion of the officials.
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.

4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.6.	Our liquor licence prohibits BYO alcohol
4.7.	Undercover pit bays please contact the Club Secretary via email to check availability
4.8.	All vehicles to be removed from the pits once trailers are parked
4.9.	Start Procedure Competition Rule – Chapter 1 Rule 22 (xxi) Any additional formation laps may be deducted from that classes scheduled race distance at the discretion of the Clerk of Course, race director or stewards of the meeting
4.10.	As per Karting WA 2020 State Regulations: General Regulations 6) d) d) Video Recording System i) It is mandatory for each kart competing in each State Series, State Cup, State Trophy and Zonal Series to have a video recording system that is mounted in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 1, Rule 8 i) (iv) and be fully operational at all times while the kart is on the track. ii) The date & time on the camera must be set to the time zone of the Meeting. e) Video Recording System – Recording Medium (SD Card) Procedures i) A separate SD card must be used for each Class or Division contested at the Meeting. ii) Prior to the commencement of the on-track activity on each day of Competition, the Recording Medium used in the camera fitted to a kart must be completely cleared and formatted. iii) No recorded vision on the Recording Medium may be deleted from the time that the on-track activity has commenced on each day of the Meeting until one (1) hour after the completion of the following Event, without the prior written permission of the Stewards.
4.11.	Camping at the track is welcomed but you will need to provide your own power arrangements. No Fires
4.12.	Clear Visors will be used at the direction of the stewards
4.13.	There are <u>NO</u> Credit Card facilities for use by drivers to pay for protest fees or fines. This must be paid for in cash to the Officials.
